BID BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Dynamic Constructors, LLC of 2100 L & A Road, Metairie, LA 70001, as Principal, and Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Parish Of St. James, St. James Parish Government (Obligee), in the full and just sum of five (5%) percent of the total amount of this proposal, including all alternates, lawful money of the United States, for payment of which sum, well and truly be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally firmly by these presents.


