1. Ochsner Occupational Health currently provides dedicated high-level Occupational Health services to Jefferson Parish Government on both East and West Banks. Ochsner Occupational Health has dedicated Occupational Health clinics in Harahan and Marrero, with after-hours services in our Urgent Care clinics in Metairie, Kenner, and Marrero. Ochsner Occupational Health and Ochsner Urgent Care clinics have access to all Jefferson Parish Government protocols within our shared computer system. Ochsner Occupational Health providers hold current medical licenses in the State of Louisiana, certified through FMCSA data base to provide DOT physicals in accordance with FMCSA guidelines. Ochsner Occupational Health has dedicated provider(s) who are trained and knowledgeable in Medical Review Officer services. Dr. Saeed is extremely experienced in the role as Medical Review Officer. Dr. Saeed understands the Safety Sensitive aspect of job duties some Jefferson Parish Government employees hold.

Ochsner Occupational Health provides a care coordination call center available 24/7 through the Ochsner Employer Connect department. Ochsner Employer Connect is a dedicated care coordination call center providing a one-stop type service for all Occupational Health employers. Ochsner Employer Connect staff possess a wide range of Occupational Health experience and knowledge. Ochsner Employer Connect offers thorough care coordination for initial and follow up assessments associated with work related injuries, specialized referrals, return to work exams, worker's comp claim management, and general appointment scheduling. Ochsner Occupational Health provides a web-based Employer Portal which grants approved Jefferson Parish Government employees access to secure data associated with employee visits and testing. For over 30 years, Ochsner Occupational Health has provided medical services to local, regional, and national clients, including Jefferson Parish Government over the last 6 years.
