

We created an economic development district entitled "Elmwood Economic Development District No. 1" and amending the boundaries thereof. This employment is pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Parish Council on September 19, 2018, and is ongoing.

We worked on a matter involving the creation of another economic development district entitled "Lafreniere Area Economic Development District," which is pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Parish Council on November 6, 2019.

Other than the foregoing, we are not aware of the firm being selected to handle any public finance matters for Jefferson Parish, although David Wolf does work on an ongoing and occasional basis with Parish Attorneys on multiple loans from the Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund and the Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund.

The firm currently handles certain Governmental Relations work for Jefferson Parish under a separate contract for such services.




