Required Provisions from Appendix I to Part 200 Contract Provisions for Non-Federal Entity Contracts under Federal Awards (Some provisions may not be applicable to the vendor depending on type of bid submitted.

In addition to the other provisions required by the Federal agency or non-Federal entity all contracts made by the non-federal entity under the Federal award must contain provisions the following as applicable.

The non-Federal entity must report all suspected or reported violations to the Federal awarding agency
- (E) Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C 3701-3708). Where applicable, all contracts awarded by the non-Federal entity in excess of \$100,000 that involve the employment of mechanics or laborers must include a provision for compliance with 40 U.S.C. 3702 and 3704, as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5). The requirements of 40 U.S.C. 3704 are applicable to construction work and provide that no laborer or mechanic must be required to work in surroundings or under working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous or dangerous. These requirements do not apply to the purchases of supplies or materials or articles ordinarily available on the open market, or contracts for transportations or transmission of intelligence
- (F) Rights of Inventions Made under a Contract or Agreement. If the Federal award meets the definition of "funding agreement" under 37 CFR §401.2 (a) and the recipient or sub recipient wishes to enter into a contract with a small business firm or nonprofit organization regarding the substitution of parties, assignment or performance of experimental developmental, or research work under that "funding agreement", the recipient or sub recipient must comply with the requirements of CFR Part 401, "Rights to Inventions Made by Nonprofit Organizations and Small Business Firms under Government Grants, Contracts and Cooperative Agreements," and any implementing regulations issued by awarding agency

- (I) Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment (31 U.S.C. 1352)- Contractors that apply or bid for an award exceeding \$100,000 must file the required certification. Each tier certified to the tier above that it will not and had not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant or any other award converted by 31 U.S.C. 1352. Required Contract Provisions from 2 CFR Part 200

1. Procurement of recovered materials – A non-Federal entity that is a state agency or agency of a political subdivision of a state and its contractors must comply with section 6002 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. The requirements of Section of Section 6002 include procuring only items designated in guidelines of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at 40 CFR part 247 that contain the highest percentage of recovered materials practicable, consistent with maintaining a satisfactory level of competition, where the purchase price of the item exceeds \$10,000 or the value of the quantity acquired by the preceding fiscal year exceeded \$10,000; procuring solid waste management services in a manner that maximizes energy and resource recovery; and establishing an affirmative procurement program for procurement of recovered materials identified in the EPA guidelines (2 CFR Part 200.322)
2. The Vendor agrees to take all necessary affirmative steps to assure that minority businesses, women's business enterprises, and labor surplus area firms are used when possible (2 CFR Part 200.321)

Required Contract Provisions from 7 CFR Part 210

1. The SFA and Vendor shall comply with the Buy American Provision from all solicitations and contracts that involve the purchase of food, USDA Regulation (7 CFR Part 250 and 7 CFR Part 210). The vendor is required to utilize, to the maximum extent practicable domestic commodities and products.

The District participates in the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program and is required and is required to use the nonprofit food service funds, to the maximum extent practical, to buy domestic commodities for program meals. A "domestic commodity or product" is defined as one that is either produced in the U.S. or is processed in the U.S. substantially using agriculture commodities that are produced in the U.S. as provided in 7 CFR part 210.21 (d). Section 129n) of the National School Lunch Act defines "domestic commodity or product" as an agricultural commodity that is produced in the U.S. and a good product that is processed in the U.S. Substantially means over 51 % of the final processed product (by weight or volume) must consist of agricultural commodities that were grown domestically. The Buy American provision must be followed in all procurements where funds are used from the nonprofit food service account, whether directly by an SFA or on its behalf.

Exceptions to the Buy American provisions should be used as a last resort; however, an alternative or exception may be approved upon request. To be considered for the alternative or exception, the request must be submitted in writing to a designated official, a minimum of day 14 days in advance or delivery. The request must include the:

A. Alternative substitute (s) that are domestic and meet the required specifications:

1. The Product is not produced or manufactured in the U.S. in sufficient and reasonably available quantities of a satisfactory quality; or
2. Competitive bids reveal the costs of a U.S. product are significantly higher than the non-domestic product.

The SFA will include the "Buy American Provision Certification form for Food Purchases in all procurements.

The Vendor must identify all food products bid by the company that do not meet the definition of “domestic” on this document. In the event the SFA receives a bid from a vendor that does not include this information, the SFA is to consider the bid non-responsive.

Processed Food Products shall be delivered weekly as per the individual school's orders. Arrangements will be made prior to the bid cycle to coordinate ordering and deliveries. The order shall be emailed/faxed/scanned to the awarding vendor the week before the delivery is requested.

Deliveries must be made to the individual schools weekly (except for holidays). Any deviations from this must have prior approval from Baker School System, Child Nutrition Department. Deliveries to the individual schools should be between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. on days that school is in session. Please notify if delivery will not be made to the schools by the approved times.

Nutritional information. Ingredient statements must be provided for each item. Please be sure to submit all nutritional information with bid.
