The undersigned, hereinafter called BIDDER, in compliance with the "Notice to Bidders," accepting all of the terms and conditions of the "Instructions to Bidders," including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid Security; proposes and agrees, if awarded the Contract, to enter into an Agreement with the OWNER in the form of Agreement included in the Contract Documents, to furnish all materials, equipment, machinery, tools, apparatus, means of transportation and labor necessary to complete the work to be performed under this Contract within the Contract Time indicated in this BID, in full and complete accordance with the shown, noted, described and reasonably intended requirements of the Contract Documents, to the full and entire satisfaction of the OWNER, for the amounts contained in the Bid Schedules.

2. This BID will remain open for **60 days** after the day of Bid opening. If awarded a contract, BIDDER will sign the Agreement and submit the Contract Security and other documents required by the Contract Documents within 15 days after the date indicated in OWNER's Notice of Award.

3. In submitting this BID, BIDDER represents that:

(a) BIDDER has become thoroughly familiar with the terms and conditions of the proposed Contract Documents accepting the same as sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all the conditions and requirements under the Contract which will be executed for the Work.

(b) BIDDER has examined the site and locality where the Work is to be performed, the legal requirements (federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations) and the conditions affecting cost, progress or performance of the Work and has made such independent investigations as BIDDER deems necessary.

(c) This BID is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; BIDDER has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other

(f) It is a condition of this BID and any subsequent contract entered into pursuant to this BID, and it shall be made a condition of each subcontract entered into pursuant to the prime contract that the Contractor and any Subcontractor shall not require any laborer or mechanic employed in performance of the contract to work in surroundings or under working conditions which are unsatisfactory, hazardous, or dangerous to his health or safety, as determined under Construction Safety and Health Standards, Title 29, CFR, Part 1518 36FR7340, promulgated by the U.S. Secretary of Labor, in accordance with Section 107 of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, 82, Stat. 96; that it is a further condition of this BID that he shall be solely responsible for the enforcement of such Construction and Health Standards, and that he definitely understands that the OWNER and his authorized representatives will not assume any liability resulting from his failure to police and enforce all such standards.

(g) The description under each bid item, being briefly stated, implies, although it does not mention, all incidentals and that prices stated are intended to cover all such work, materials and incidentals as constitute BIDDER's obligations as described in the Specifications, and any details not specifically mentioned, but evidently included in the Contract shall be compensated for in the item which most logically includes it.
