





- A line item has been added for Fire Hydrant with Isolation Valve. Two (2) Fire Hydrants are called out to have an isolation valve.
- All ductile iron pipe (DIPW-1) has been removed from project. A note requiring joints to be restrained 72' before and after the polyethylene pipe directional drill sections has been added.
- The DIPW-1 line items have been removed and associated quantities have been modified.
- A section of PEPW-1 (Directional Drill Installation) has been added to the front of E135th Street.
- Pay items for short and long water services shall be made on a strictly per each basis. The unit price shall include, in addition to the items shown on the detail sheet, compensation for all service tubing required to make the service tap.
